

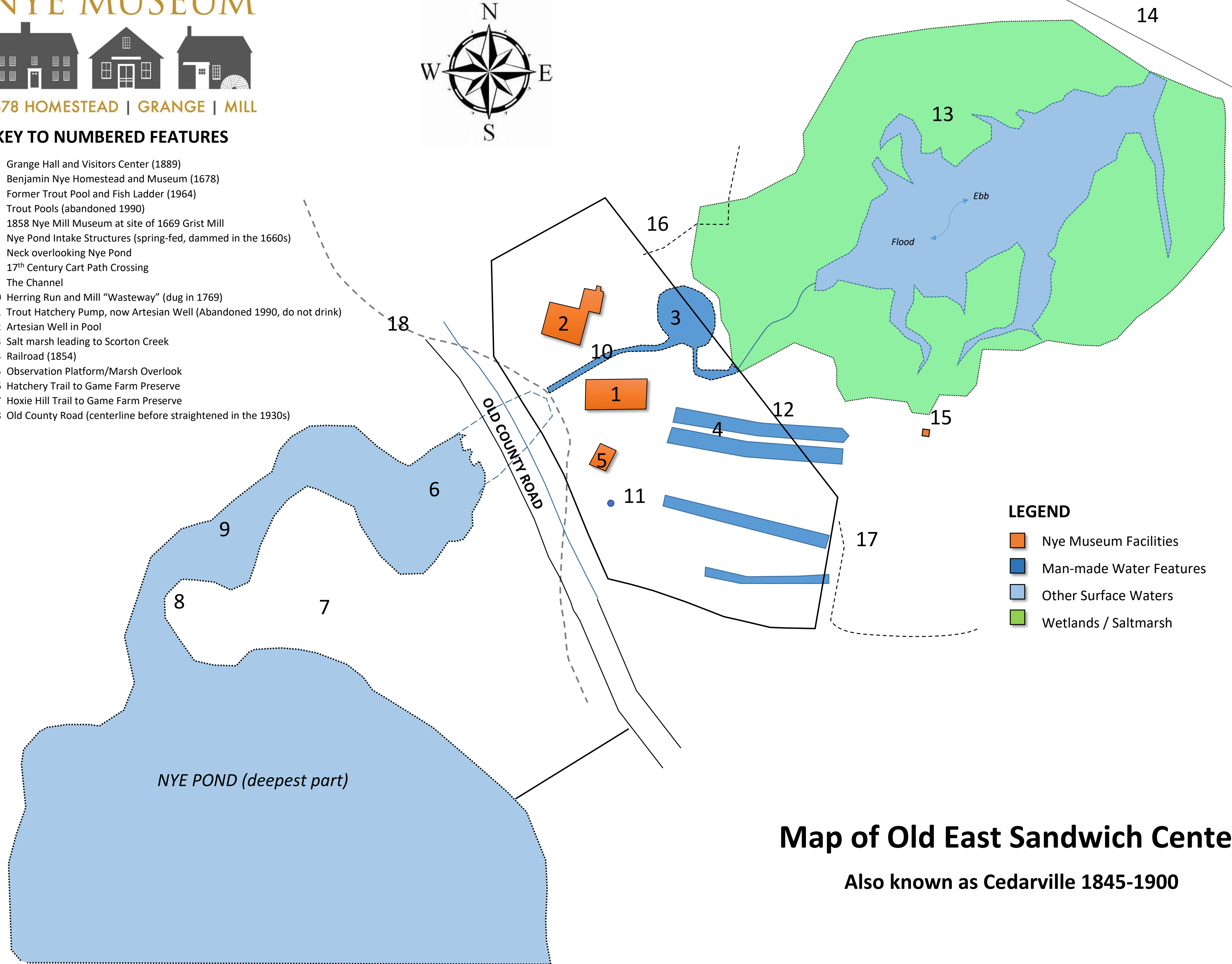

- 4 Trout Pools (abandoned 1990)
- 5 1858 Nye Mill Museum at site of 1669 Grist Mill
- 6 Nye Pond Intake Structures (spring-fed, dammed in the 1660s)
- 7 Neck overlooking Nye Pond
- 8 17th Century Cart Path Crossing
- 9 The Channel
- 10 Herring Run and Mill "Wasteway" (dug in 1769)
- 11 Trout Hatchery Pump, now Artesian Well (Abandoned 1990, do not drink)
- 12 Artesian Well in Pool
- 13 Salt marsh leading to Scorton Creek
- 14 Railroad (1854)
- 15 Observation Platform/Marsh Overlook
- 16 Hatchery Trail to Game Farm Preserve
- 17 Hoxie Hill Trail to Game Farm Preserve
- 18 Old County Road (centerline before straightened in the 1930s)
